Pastor's View

Dear Siblings in Christ,

The adult education class just finished up reading and discussing Dietrich Bonhoeffer's book *Life Together*. We had rich discussion about what community is, how do we live together and with others, and how do we continually try to see others as God sees them. As we wrapped up we discussed "so what do we do with this now?" We read this book, we've had fabulous conversations, but what are we going to do so that our reading and our conversation matters beyond the hour in class on Sundays.

In some ways, our season of Lent is like this. We spend this 40-day season reflecting on our need for God's grace and mercy that comes through the cross of Jesus Christ. Perhaps you give up or add something to your life as a part of a practice of Lent. As a parish we will collect jars of peanut butter. There are so many ways to engage with a Lenten practice of noticing the world around us in a new way and being aware of our need for God's forgiveness. Just as we discussed in adult education the "so what" of reading *Life Together*, I ask you this same question about Lent. So what? How will our lives be different after this season of intentional noticing? The reality is that only you can answer this for yourself, but it is a question I invite you to explore. This is not meant to add to your already long to-do lists, but is meant as an invitation to add depth to our Lenten season because our daily practice of faith matters to this world. This change does not need to be something grandiose and spectacular, indeed it is usually the smallest things known only to us and to God that make the biggest difference.

I pray that this Lenten season brings each of us closer to God, grows our awareness of our need for God's grace and mercy, and reminds us again in new ways of our belovedness through Jesus Christ.

Pastor's Report

- All committees meeting in January went well.
- Visits and adult education going well.
- Confirmation will be May 21. She will conduct the service.
- Had regular first-year evaluation meeting with synod rep, Mary, and Mark.
- Reviewed personnel and child protection policies for annual synod forms.
- Pulpit supply during her maternity leave is being arranged. Volunteers have stepped forward to cover some worship services and visits to the homebound.
- The church secretary resigned effective Friday, February 3. Met with council presidents Mary and Mark to plan the steps for hiring another secretary. Met with PCC to work out job description, compensation package, and job posting. Several people have volunteered to help with putting together bulletins and newsletters.
- Counseling a couple planning a wedding at Our Savior's on August 12.
