Feeding the Children

Faith and Our Savior's will again be preparing food bags to provide weekend meals for Calamus-Wheatland students selected by the school counselor.

The Outreach Committee is coordinating the project and volunteers are in place for packing bags and delivering food to the school on Friday mornings.

Below is a list of non-perishable food items church members may contribute to the project.

Feeding the Children

Eight Cal/Wheat Elementary students are each given a bag of food to take home on Fridays.

You can help by donating food.

Requirements:

- Single-serving items
- Individually wrapped items
- Must be shelf-stable

Examples:

- Individual oatmeal packages
- > Individual cereal boxes
- Cereal bars
- Mac-n-cheese (or other pasta) cups to microwave
- Individual chicken or tuna packages
- Small jars of peanut butter
- > Soups
- Individual crackers and cheese packages
- Individual crackers and peanut butter packages
- > Fruit cups
- Juice boxes (100% real juice)
