Dear Siblings in Christ,

As we move into a new calendar year, this time can be filled with anticipation. Anticipation of what the year will bring, anticipation of coming changes (good, bad, and somewhere in between), anticipation of what we plan to do, and so forth. Some make New Year's resolutions, some hope that this year is better than last year, and perhaps others are even just neutral about the whole deal. No matter how you are feeling about this particular new year, I imagine that at some point all of us have felt that expectant anticipation of a new year, that feeling of "this is MY year!"
