Pastor's View June 2018

Things that I have learned in May:

Internship Supervisor's Meeting

- 1. Wartburg is one of the smaller seminaries in the ELCA. Yet it has a large class of incoming students. Why? The majority of the students are Collaborative Learning students. These students are in a situation where they are working in a church and going to seminary at the same time. The seminary also has a sizable number of Distant Learners. These students attend classes online and also in the classroom. The smallest number of students are the traditional on campus students.
- 2. Wartburg is working with Wartburg College in developing a six-year program to get your college degree and your seminary degree. This would be a savings in time and money for the students. It will also help raise the number of Pastors on the rostered clergy list.
- 3. Warburg shared that they have learned that they must try new things in ministry so that they may continue to serve the greater Church. They may not be successful in everything they try. But they know that they cannot continue to do things the way they have always been done in the past.
- 4. Calamus Lutheran Congregations are not doing things as usual. We as a church are looking at ways to provide rostered ministry to our community. We are looking at new ways of providing called clergy for our community. Please continue to pray for our work to provide clergy to Calamus.

Deans Meeting

Most of the Dean's meeting centered on the topic and questions of the restructuring of the Synod Governance Proposal. The purpose of this restructuring is to bring new persons into the synod governance so the synod can listen and react to what is happening in the synod.

First Call Theological Education Meeting

- 1. The theme for the first call Pastors was Evangelism. Pastor Mike Householder (Hope) said the best evangelism is when we get out of the way and let the Holy Spirit lead. He also said that the best evangelism happens when we have "Jonah" bruises. When we have tried things that have not worked and we return to God to try again.
- 2. Other thoughts: Find the ministry in your community. Do what is possible in your own setting. Don't try to do evangelism from someone else. Look to God.
- 3. Evangelism is stopped by fear. We have fears that stop what we can do. We are afraid of guns, hate crimes, race, and poverty. In these fears we need to look to see where God is working.
