Pastor's View

It's Friday, but Sunday's Coming!

Although it has not been a particularly bad winter, by this time of the season people begin to become winter weary. The days are cold, cloudy and dark. This is the time of the year when people suffer from depression and mood-altering disorders. It is not always easy to find the good in these dark days. All I can say is, *it's Friday*, *but Sunday's coming!*

I heard that in a speech at a religious gathering. The speaker was Pastor Tony Campolo. He was referring to Good Friday and Easter. He was reminding us that no matter how bad things seem at the moment, it does get better. Just think of how the people felt on Good Friday. Jesus, whom they trusted to free them from oppression, was dead. All they had hoped for died that Friday with Jesus. They were devastated. Then comes Sunday and suddenly their devastation turns to rejoicing. Jesus was not dead. Jesus was raised from the dead to save everyone. It was an Alleluia moment.

I invite you to join me during this season of Lent as we walk with Jesus to the cross. It begins with Ash Wednesday on February 26. Then for the next five Wednesdays we will come together for a meal at 6:00 p.m. and worship at 6:30 p.m. Our worship will focus on the Hands of Lent.

The service will conclude by 7:00 p.m., so if you have young children there will be time to get them home and ready for the next day.

We will conclude Lent with Holy Week services. Maundy Thursday is April 9, 6:30 p.m. at Faith and Good Friday, April 10, 6:30 p.m. at Our Savior's. Our Easter Sunday services are 7:00 a.m. at Faith and 9:30 a.m. at Our Savior's. Don't forget to enjoy the delicious Easter Breakfast served by our youth at 8:00 a.m. at Faith.

I encourage you to come to the services each Wednesday and Holy Week. The Easter Sunday celebration is much more meaningful when you have walked with Jesus to the cross and are at the foot of the cross when he dies. We can get through this together if we remember, *it's Friday, but Sunday's coming!*
