Pastor's View

I'm writing this article the day after a meeting was held with the Calamus Parish joint council and the Worship committee. By the time you read this, you may have received the news that worship will remain online through June. There will be no in-house worship for the time being. I know this is not what most of us want to hear, but I want you to know that your council and worship committee made their decision thoughtfully and with much discussion.

I was pleased to watch this council and worship committee interact and prayerfully make a decision. All people were heard and their opinions were respectfully taken into consideration. Not everyone agreed and there were members who voted for each of the three options. In the end the majority decided we need one more month before considering changing the way we are doing worship. Another meeting will take place on June 14, so we can see how Covid-19 is affecting us now that businesses are beginning to open up.

I have attended many council meetings and have served on a church council and I want to thank all those who were in attendance at this meeting. This is one of the most respectful meetings I have attended when there has been a major decision to make and not all members were in agreement as to what should be done. Please know this was not an easy decision to make and these members need to be commended for their faithfulness.

When we do come back together for in-house worship, I think it is important to recognize that worship will not be as we remember. At least not for the foreseeable future. If we had begun in-house worship now there would be no communion, no singing, no passing the peace, and no greeting each other before or after worship. People would only sit with their immediate family in every third pew and would be seated from the front to the back as you come in. There would be no sitting in your favorite pew. With all these restrictions, it makes worship very different.

All that being said, I cannot wait for the time when we are together in worship, but until then, I am grateful that I can provide a weekly service for you.
