Pastor's View

Dear Siblings in Christ,

As I write this, four of our youth, Heather Grau, and myself are just days away from leaving for the ELCA Youth Gathering. I am so excited for this opportunity for us and I am expectant for how the Holy Spirit will move and direct us at the Youth Gathering in New Orleans and how the Spirit's movement there will cause movement here in our parish.

The theme for the Youth Gathering this year is "Created to Be." I will let our four young people who attended share more about what that theme means and has meant to them before, during, and after the gathering. However, in light of this theme, I wanted to touch on how all of us are "Created to Be."

When we were each born God created us with unique and particular gifts, and in baptism we are invited to share those gifts with the world for Jesus's sake as a response to what Jesus has done for us. The "fancy" sounding word for this is vocation, which just means all the roles we have in life. In each of our roles, or vocations, we get to share the love of Jesus with the world. You have been created to be the church, and the world needs you to do so. Thanks be to God for the privilege of being the church together in this time and place. Thanks be to God for the faithful witness to the gospel that we in Calamus Lutheran Parish strive for in the world. Thanks be to God for each of you and the ways you live out who God created you to be in this world.


Movie Set – Jason has not heard anything further from Cocoon Productions about using Our Savior's as a location for a movie.
